Innes Park is conveniently situated just 15 km east of Bundaberg. Along this stretch of coastline, you'll discover numerous reef breaks, and the locals are your go-to source for insider information on the best spots. With local conveniences including a bakery and café, two golf courses including restaurants and a convenience store, Innes Park really has everything you need.

Nestled on the coast, further north of Innes Park, is Burnett Heads. A beachside lifestyle that has captured the imagination of many. A highlight of the town is Oaks Beach, a 200-metre stretch of sandy shoreline that provides a safe haven for surfing and swimming. Fishing enthusiasts are drawn to the rocks and greynes at Oaks Beach, which offer the best opportunities to reach deeper waters, to try their luck catching a fish.

The Port of Bundaberg is another notable feature of Burnett Heads. It is a hub for fresh local seafood, offering a delightful waterfront dining experience.

Shane also recommends exploring the localities of Iliranyan, Sharon, Apple Tree Creek, Gooburnum, South Bingers, Oakwood, Childers and Gin Gin.

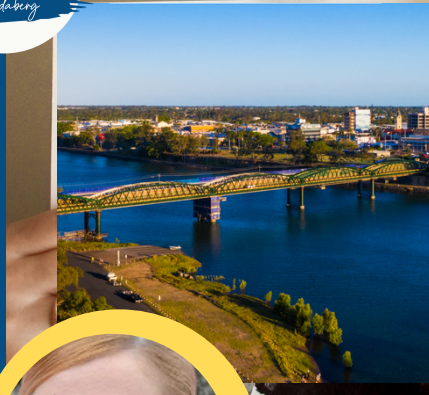

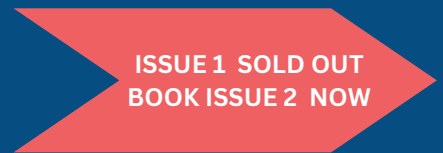
